Discipline Policy

Prettyboy HomeBASE/Tiny Tots program uses a positive guidance method of discipline including reminders, distractions, logical consequences and redirection. We teach self-management skills according to the following:

- Rules are clearly stated. We count on our children to work and play within these limits
- We expect behavior to be age and developmentally appropriate.
- We develop an atmosphere of trust for children to know that they will not be hurt nor allowed to hurt others.
- Children will be redirected to another center by staff members in order to avoid conflict.
- Staff members work to help children become acquainted with their feelings. This helps them to learn to cope with their feelings and control them responsibly, learn to make better choices and guide them to become more independent.
- Child safety is the most important concern of the program. Children whose behavior is dangerous or repeatedly disruptive must be immediately removed from the area.
- Repeated disruptive or dangerous behavior will be discussed with parents and will result in termination from the program.
